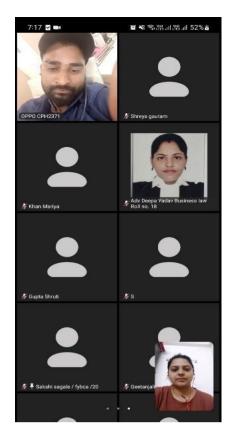

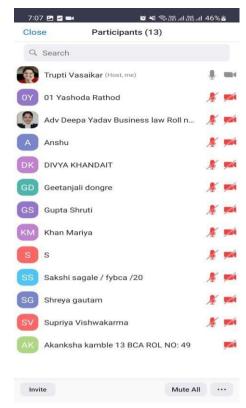

- 2) Do not post anything that you would not want your family, other students, teachers, or current and future employers to see! Connect with care. Do not click on links or open emails from people you do not know.
- 3) Cyber criminals use emails and links that look okay to lure people into clicking. If you think an offer is too good to be true, it probably is. Use strong passwords. Try not to use the same password for multiple sites.
- 4) Make passwords strong and change them often. Keep your belongings safe. Lock your computer and mobile phone.
